AFFIDAVIT OF FACT



I, Yakubu Kabu, Male, Christian, and Nigerian Citizen of Chibok town in Chibok Local Government do hereby swear an oath and state as follows:

1. That I am the elder brother to Lydia Pogu and uncle of Joy Bishara both escaped Chibok girls presently schooling abroad and by virtue of this, I am conversant with the facts herein deposed.
2. That in June 2014, I and my sister Lydia Pogu and niece Joy Bishara traveled from Chibok to Abuja to meet with Mr. and Mrs Paul Gadzama
3. That in Abuja we met at the US embassy with Congresswoman Sheila Jackson Lee, Congresswoman Fredrica Wilson, Congressman Stockman, Congresswoman Frankel and Barrister Emmanuel Ogebe who were visiting from the US
4. That after our meeting at the embassy we met with the Gadzamas and Barrister Ogebe who showed genuine care and concern for the plight of my nieces and my own daughter Dorcas who is still missing.
5. That the Gadzamas offered to host my nieces in their home in Jos pending while Barrister Ogebe looked for continuing education opportunities for them abroad. I consulted their parents and other family members who all agreed.
6. That ultimately on August 31, 2014, Lydia and Joy were in the first batch of girls to be airlifted to the US to school after the Gadzamas' organization Education Must Continue Initiative processed their passports and visas.
7. That these arrangements were done with the full knowledge and awareness of their families.
