
Finally our client is hereby appealing for a cease fire from the Nigeria Embassy in Washington whose late ambassador showered commendations and accolades on the initiator of this program and even offered the girls launch - till date the only kindness from their government since they went to America in 2014. It is unfortunate that the present leadership at the embassy is continuing with the hostile and combative approach of the previous administration instead of acknowledging the need for change.

Kindly ask your embassy to cease and desist from further interference and from instigating the US government to bother our girls in school. Their daughters are not enthused by all of these distractions from their studies.
