OUR CHIBOK GIRLS ON EDUCATION MUST CONTINUE INITIATIVE'S (EMCI'S) SPONSORSHIP TO USA

- 1. We are parents/guardians and family members of the Chibok schoolgirls sent to school in the US by Education Must Continue Initiative.
- 2. We are really disturbed by the Nigerian Embassy's position in the USA through the activities of one Ezinne Osuigwe and her cohorts who have conspired with a mischievous American who is raising \$300,000 allegedly to pay for their school fees, while in actual fact the girls have left that school 9 months ago and he had originally given "full scholarship." This unscrupulous American also offered our daughters to other people on the condition that they pay him money and delayed our daughters in his school for two days to keep them from our Church members and visiting friends and family from Borno.
- 4. The same embassy personnel, Ezinne Osiugwe, has been causing disaffection by instigating our daughters to disown Barrister Emmanuel Ogebe who is our designated EMC guardian and custodian in the US. She even went to a demeaning and fraudulent level of causing a letter to be typed and asking them to sign purporting to be from them disowning Mr. Ogebe, but the girls refused to be lured into such a scheme. - 3. Ezinne then colluded with her friend Somiari Demm to threaten the girls that the embassy won't help them if they don't agree to write false statements against Mr. Emmanuel. When this failed, Somiari assisted by Ezinne (the embassy personnel) have been raising funds online allegedly for us the parents in an effort to induce the girls to turn against EMC and buy into her manipulation. However although Somiari and Ezinne raised over \$2000 online, we have never received a dime from the duo. For them to malign Mr. Ogebe and the Gadzamas who assisted us at the most desperate situation of our lives is to say the least callous, wicked and sadistic and not expected of an embassy meant to promote and not damage the image of Nigeria and Nigerians.
